

**Credo Christian High Communicable Disease Plan for Students and Staff**  
**September 1, 2022**

BC Independent Schools are required by the Ministry of Education and Child Care to maintain a communicable disease plan.

Our planned health and safety measures include:

1. Public Health Measures
  - a. CCHS will cooperate with Fraser Health and the Ministry of Education in any communication to the school community that concerns public health.
2. Environmental Measures
  - a. A full cleaning of the school building will take place once per school day.
3. Administrative Measures
  - a. Students who become ill while at school will be assessed by the school nurse. If deemed necessary, they will be isolated, and parents will be requested to bring them home.
  - b. The school will not ask for proof of vaccination for any student or staff member. No school-sponsored event that takes place on school property will require proof of vaccination. The school will not organize off-campus events that require proof of vaccination for students. If such events require proof of vaccination for adults, the school will determine if the event can be safely supervised.
4. Personal Measures
  - a. Students and staff who are sick should not attend school. If health advice is needed, they should consult a health professional (e.g. phone 811).
  - b. Students and staff are encouraged to wash or sanitize their hands regularly through signage in washrooms.
  - c. Students and staff should maintain good hygienic practices, including coughing or sneezing into their sleeve.
5. Personal protective equipment
  - a. The school does not require masks. Students and staff who prefer to wear a mask are welcome to do so. Masks are available in the office.

While our trust is ultimately in God (Ps 46: 1-3) we must continue to act responsibly to protect ourselves and our neighbor, including our fellow staff members and students. As such, we thank you for your cooperation.
